



Winter Padel League Rules

1. A match is 2 tie-break sets.
 2. Each set is to 6 games. If you get to **5 games all**, play a tie-break to 7 points to decide who wins the set.
(The score will then be 6:5)
 3. Each game will count as a point towards your league score. For example, if you lose both sets 6-4, 6-4 you get 8 points. This means that every game counts.
 4. Please contact your opponents via WhatsApp to arrange your matches. Give a range of date and time options on your specific league's WhatsApp group and agree who will book the court.
 5. Play starts on Monday 8th December and you have until 2nd February 2026 to complete your matches. **Please only sign up if you have the time to play your matches within this period.**
- *The first pair across all of the leagues to complete their matches will receive a 3 point bonus to their league score.
6. Any team that does not complete all their matches will be 'fined' £20, this will go towards the Poole Field Development Fund. Many matches were not played in the summer league and it negatively impacted other members' experience. You have been warned! *(In a friendly way)*
 7. Once a match is completed, please record the score on the boards inside the 'Bus Stop' shed by the courts. Find your



team on the left hand side of the table and follow across to the correct opponent's column.

Write how many games you won in each set – e.g. 6 and 5

It will look like this:
